PARTICIPATION *Individuals* who meet the criteria above may cast 1 vote. *Organisations* may send delegates (who satisfy the eligibility criteria) on the following basis. *CLPs* 5 delegates/votes; *Ward parties* – 2 dels/votes; *National TUs* 5 dels/votes; *Regional/Area TUs* – 3 dels/votes; *TU branches* 2 dels/votes; *CND Regions/Areas/Groups* – 2 dels/votes.

REGISTRATION in advance or on the day. No fee is payable to attend the AGM only.

NOMINATIONS Eligible participants may make nominations for Labour CND officers and EC by post or email no later than **Wed 5 May**. Positions for nomination are: Co-chairs (2 places) Vice Chair (2) Treasurer (1) Secretary (1) Assistant Sec (1) EC members (16) Regional representatives (1 per region)

RESOLUTIONS Eligible participants may submit one resolution for voting which must be received in writing (post or email) no later than **Wed 5 May**. Amendments will be taken from the floor of the meeting if submitted in writing before the chair closes the debate.
